**The Activity:** It’s awards night. The envelope is opened and then quite unexpectedly, the host of the event, Mr. Bill Colons, damns your performance ... and everybody else’s! It is an outrage! In that time they are given a brief on their roles and how to use their digital video cameras and spend their \$1 million budget.

The teams will need to allocate themselves to the many tasks outlined in the Organizational Chart to make a hit movie. Your teams can “buy” a pre-written script or they can create their own scripts that feature the objective of the conference or create a totally new masterpiece.

In addition to the movie making, the teams need to create the all-important movie

poster and an energizing introduction to their movies ... both contributing to the final score.

**Timing:** Ideally the films will be screened that night over dinner.

**Facilitation:** Unlike a typical team building facilitator, your Make-A-Movie Film Festival event will be hosted by our trained professional actors to keep your event fun and focused and to help you every step of the way.

**Setting:** We recommend a private function a dining room.

**Group Size:** 8 – 800 participants

**Timing:** The film making portion of the program is designed to take 2 hours and the overall program 3 hours or more.
