

Teamwork Poker

Teamwork Poker is a unique and exciting combination of *Texas Hold 'em Poker* and *teambuilding*. This fast-paced tournament event helps teach and coach your group in the popular game of Texas Hold 'em while challenging them as teams and team couples to find the most effective way to outplay rivals on their way to the grand prize.

Your group is divided teams. The teams are assigned tables of eight so they can begin training as a group and learn the basics and strategies of Texas Hold 'em Poker from our poker expert. Each player receives a Poker guide they can use during the tournament. Face-up practice play follows allowing players to practice what they've learned.

Each team will be determining their experienced players from their novice players so they can pair off into team couples. One team couple per table will sit side-by-side during Tournament play. Team couples can look at each others cards and discuss the strategy for each hand played by sharing their written suggestions using pads of paper.

During the Training and Practice session, we will project Poker Trivia Questions with multiple choice answers on the screen. The questions are designed to further teach the group about poker before the tournament starts.

During The Tournament, players will be moved every 15 to 30 minutes. Each team couple will get a new partner and each table will have 4 new players.

How long is the program? 2.5 to 4 hours depending upon the size of the group and how long the client wants the tournament and final table



play to last. The eight players at the Final Table start with the same amount of chips. The team with the most chips at the end of the playing time will win the Team Prize.

Benefits: Teamwork, Strategy, Planning, Taking risks, and the satisfaction of competing in an exciting tournament filled with crucial decisions, pit falls and rewards! Plus you'll learn the game of Texas Hold'em!

De-brief: We can do a de-briefing about how poker and games in general relate to strategies, risks and rewards found in all business situations.

Minimum/Maximum Group Size: There are 8 players per table. Group size can be 24 to 128 players in increments of 8.

Space Requirements: Each poker table (8' x 4') will hold 8 players and a dealer. We need approximately 160 to 200 sq ft per table.
