Each team or individual starts out as an intern and attempts to climb the ranks and

become the chairperson. Teams are formed with a mix of employees from different departments so they have a chance to meet and work with different people. Every correct answer brings the team or individual closer to the top. This fast paced game show engages the entire team and is easily customized for any size group. It's energizing and enlightening at the same time, and your team will enjoy every minute of it!



**Here's how it works:** Three teams at a time are invited to the “stage” to play. Each round contains 30 questions and it takes 12 correct answers to reach the top. If no one reaches the top, the player(s) with the highest number of point wins!
