Building Teams and Raising Spirits!

Operation Military Care is a program that gives back to our men and women in uniform while helping your team come together in a myriad of fun and productive ways. This impactful program includes fast-paced, competitive and engaging team-building activities that lead up to the final challenge – care package assembly for our military heroes!

Your teams have all the fun and TeamBonding coordinates all logistics, leads and facilitates the program and provides high quality gifts that include the Top 20 most requested items for our service men and women. Packages are created for soldiers who rarely or never receive anything from home. Teams really make a difference by acknowledging their service and providing these special gifts.



The Activity:

Groups are broken into sub-teams and placed in different starting locations. From the start, these teams are required to gather items and materials that will comprise the care packages.

To inspire teamwork and cooperation, teams are spread over a large area and travel is a challenge. Teams must use “stepping stones”(walking pads) during the journey. From competition to collaboration, teams realize that only a shared, concerted effort will allow the project task to be completed on time. Together, four different activities, each using a different skill set, must be completed to earn the points that are needed to “purchase” care package items. Activities include:

On Target – a mini-scavenger hunt that ups the ante as teams race the clock to beat goals and earn points. Cooperation is key as teams identify and create the ultimate controlled time-efficient system.

Travel Stones and Hole in One – a multi-tasking/problem solving initiative involving a large ball, a series of strings and a drop zone! Teams create a human machine that requires balance and total teamwork!

Speedline – a planning and strategy game involving sequencing and requiring communication systems to get the most points.

ZEN – learning by doing activity of “debugging” a system through trial and error. Watch the competition get tougher as teams strive to beat other teams benchmarks.

At the end of the activities, teams use their points to purchase items for the care packages for their soldiers. This is the highlight of the event as teams are eager to give back to such a worthy and rewarding cause. After the packages are created, teams tally their points and the real “winning” team is declared — our troops overseas!

Optional Debrief: We offer an optional post-activity facilitated discussion, which of course can be customized to underscore your event theme, company positioning, etc. This is one project that will be talked about for months in the workplace!
