The teams are then given challenge paperwork that has them searching for clues and objects strategically hidden around the neighborhood. Teams set out to search for these specially placed locked boxes that contain essential items within. But there's a catch: each box has a different lock, and each team begins the event with only a couple of keys. Teams use shrewd negotiating and keen observation to trade and earn keys along the way.

Once the teams collect their treasures from each of the hidden boxes, they race back to decode their final riddle (using the items they have collected along the way). The skills teams use to trade their keys and collect their items, are completely different from the skills they need to solve the riddle, making this one of TeamBonding's most creatively diverse team-strategizing programs.

Keys to Success brings out participants' sense of humor, spirit of adventure, as well as important skills like organization, negotiation, and teamwork. It's an extremely effective way to challenge your team to rely on their brains – and each other – in a fun and entertaining way.



PROGRAM LENGTH:

Approximately 2 - 3 hours, depending on the number of teams involved.

GROUP SIZE:

15 - 150

TEAM SIZE:

6 - 8 people per team

SPACE REQUIREMENTS:

An urban environment is ideal, however we can make any outdoor area accommodate this event. Teams typically work within a one-square-mile play zone.
