Each of the movie production houses (your teams) is given the task of creating a Hollywood Blockbuster in the next two hours. In that time, they are briefed on their roles and challenges, including how to use their digital video cameras and spend their \$1 million budget. Each team assigns members to perform the many tasks and roles required to make a hit movie. The *Make A Movie* festival event is hosted by our trained professional actors to keep the event fun and focused, as well as to help guide teams every step of the way.

Creative thinking as well as time and resource management skills will be at play, as teams rush to complete their films for the screening. The decisions are in their hands, along with the talent, strategy and star-power needed to succeed! How will they approach the task?

In addition to making a movie, teams must design and create their blockbuster's all-important movie poster, as well as an energizing introduction to present their movies. These factors will contribute to their final score.

AWARDS:

Our standard prizes for *Make A Movie* are certificates for each of the category winners in:

- Best Actor
- Best Actress
- Best Direction and Script

The overall winning team will receive a mini-Oscar trophy!



PROGRAM LENGTH:

Approximately 2 hours for filming. After filming, the movies are edited by TeamBonding (can take multiple hours and depends on how many teams there are). The movies are then screened and voted upon at the festival – each team's movie is 2 - 3 minutes.

GROUP SIZE:

12 - 120+

TEAM SIZE:

8 - 12 people per team

SPACE REQUIREMENTS:

A private function room is ideal for the start and conclusion of the event. The facility should have plenty of space indoors and out for the teams to spread out and direct their masterpiece. We require a minimum of 2 hours between the end of team filming to edit the prepare for the Film Festival.

IDEAL USE:

- Conference/meeting breaks
- Award trips
- Retreats and celebrations
